- c. <u>Shoulder Pocket</u>. One end of the shoulder pocket $(18.5-22.5 \text{ cm} \times 8.5-11.5 \text{ cm})$ shall be stitched onto the exterior surface of the back outer cover of the jacket, while the other end shall have a Velcro patch $(9-10 \text{ cm} \times 16-19 \text{ cm})$ and a loop on the edge.
- d. <u>Collar Pocket</u>. 02 (Two) in no collar pockets shall be permanently fixed to the jacket (As per sample). Each pocket should have a provision for opening and closing with Velcro to allow insertion of collar panels. Additionally, there should be a provision for overlapping the collars at the front with Velcro (4-6 cm x 4-6 cm).



- e. <u>Cover Groin Guard</u>. The cover groin guard should be made of the same fabric as the armour cover of the jacket and should house the soft armour panel for the groin. The entire cover groin guard shall be detachable and secured with 02 (two) Velcro strips (9–11 cm x 3–5 cm) stitched on its exterior side, as per the BN sample.
- f. <u>Circumference of Neck</u>. Circumference of the neck of outer cover of the jacket should be 64-68 cm after stitching the collar and inserting the soft armour panel inside the outer fabric.

- 17. <u>Instruction for Stitching</u>. All Velcro patches should be double-stitched, with the inner stitch positioned 1 cm away from the outer stitch. Kevlar or an equivalent thread shall be used for stitching the soft armour panels. A certificate from the original manufacturer of the Flak Jacket must be submitted with the offer, stating that the fabrication and stitching of the outer cover, ballistic panels, and all other parts of the offered jacket have been done in their own factory.
- 18. <u>Anti Trauma Material</u>. All soft armour panels (front, back, collar, shoulder and groin) should have good anti trauma material to minimize the trauma effect.
- 19. Shelf Life. The minimum shelf life of the Flak Jacket (NIJ Level IIIA) (Digital Combat Colour) must be 10 years. A Shelf-Life Certificate from the manufacturer should be provided with the offer.
- 20. <u>Ballistic Test</u>. The jacket must qualify for ballistic and bulletproof tests. Each part of **one** randomly selected complete sample will be tested for resistance to ballistic penetration and Back Face Signature (BFS). Complete penetration or any BFS depth measurement in the backing material greater than 44 mm (1.73 inches) from any fair hit shall constitute a failure. The sample must qualify the ballistic test as mentioned below:

- 21. <u>Washing Test, Dye Fastness to Sunlight Test and Water Resistance Test (Outer Cover Cloth of Jacket)</u>. Supplied sample (Outer Cover Cloth of Jacket) should qualify Washing Test, Dye Fastness to Sunlight Test and Water Resistance Test. Description of the tests are as follows:
 - a. Washing Test. The Sample will be kept in the reagent of 0.5% soap flakes for 1.5 hrs at 60°C. Sample subjected to the washing test with a minimum grading of 3 out of 4 will be accepted.

- b. <u>Dye Fastness to Sunlight Test</u>. If the sample passes the washing test, it will be subjected to a dry fastness test. A minimum grading of 3 out of 4 in this test will be accepted.
- c. <u>Water Resistance Test (Cone Test)</u>. The supplied sample will be subjected to the cone test. A minimum grading of 3 out of 4 in this test will be accepted.

22. Labelling.

 - (2) To check level of ballistic protection a statement stated that "This carrier offers no ballistic protection without ballistic panels being inserted" for the user. This warning to be written with letters at least twice the size of rest of the type on the label.
 - (3) Size
 - (4) Lot number.
 - (5) Date of manufacture.
 - (6) Care instructions.
 - (7) Any special condition for washing/use.
- 23. <u>Inspection Certificate</u>. All components of the jacket should have printed inspection certificate of the manufacturer with the year and month of manufacture.
- 24. <u>Manufacturer's Certificate</u>. A Certificate from the manufacturer is to be provided, stating that the items offered are original, brand new, unused and produced in the year 2025 or later. It is also to be certified that the offered items will comply the technical specification mentioned in Para 2, 13 to 16.
- 25. <u>Sample</u>. 02 (Two) complete sets of the offered Flak Jacket are to be supplied with the offer for tender evaluation and Ballistic Test (as per para 20). The size of sample should be clearly mentioned. **Offers without samples will not be accepted.**

- 02 (Two) sets of instructions for preservation and long-term storage manuals (in English) are to be supplied with the Flak Jackets.

29. Warranty.

- Minimum 12 (twelve) months warranty from the date of final acceptance by the buyer for trouble free use is to be provided by the manufacturer. If any defect/discrepancy arises in any supplied item(s)/component(s) within the warranty period, the warranty period for the relevant item(s)/component(s) shall be automatically extended by the specific duration from the date of notification to the supplier until the date of rectification of the defect or resolution of the discrepancy.
- If any defect/discrepancy arises within the warranty period, the item(s)/component(s) are to be replaced free of cost, including freight, within 03 (three) months from the date of notification to the supplier. In this regard, the supplier must furnish an undertaking with the offer stating, "We do hereby assure that we take the liability to replace all item(s)/component(s) free of cost, including freight, within 03 (three) months from the date of notification about the defect/discrepancy of the item(s)/component(s) by the buyer, if it occurs within the period of warranty." For warranty replacement, the supplier will collect the defective item(s) from NSD Chattogram and re-supply the same to the collecting place.
- A 'Warranty Certificate' must be submitted with the offer. C.
- Guarantee must be given that the supplied quantity Flak Jacket will be suitable 30. to meet the purpose and specifications mentioned in preceding Paragraphs 2, 13 to 16 and that its performance will remain effective in all respects throughout the shelf life. A Guarantee Certificate is to be submitted with the offer.

The Ballistic Test, Washing Test, Dye Fastness to Sunlight Test, and Water Resistance Test procedures will be as specified in paragraphs 20 and 21, respectively. The tests and trials will be conducted by NAIO and the appropriate organizations, and the supplier's representative must be present throughout the process.
